Spring (March - May)

Fluvac Innovator EHV4/1 (Influenza, Rhino Type 1 and 4)

Potomac Horse Fever

Eastern and Western Encephalomyelitis

Tetanus **Or within 6 months of a cut

West Nile Virus Vaccine

Pinnacle I.N. (Intranasal Strangles) for horses under 3 years

Other vaccinations to consider: Rabies, Equine Viral Arteritis (EVA)

Summer (August) Performance Horses

Fluvac Innovator EHV4/1

Fall (November) All horses

Fluvac Innovator EHV4/1

Pregnant Mares

Pneumabort K + 1B (Abortigenic Type 1P and 1B Rhino)

Administer at 3, 5, 7, 9 months of gestation

Vaccinate with all vaccines 6 to 8 weeks prior to foaling

Foals (From Vaccinated Mares)

West Nile, Tetanus, Eastern & Western Encephalomyelitis, Flu, Rhino,

Potomac Horse Fever–3 doses 4-6 weeks between doses starting at 4-6 months old with last dose given between 10-12 months of age.

Pinnacle I.N. (Intranasal Strangles) Give 2 doses 3-4 weeks between doses starting at 5 months of age. 3rd dose recommended at 12 months of age.

(From Unvaccinated Mares)

Start vaccines at 3-4 months of age giving 3 doses 3-4 weeks apart.

Deworming

Quest Plus or Ivermectin - (November, December, January)

Anthelcide - (February, March, April)

Quest Plus - (May, June, July)

Exodus - (August, September, October)

***Foals-starting at 1 month of age-every month until 6 months old with Panacur or Anthelcide
